

Tourist traffic organisation in connection with the red epidemiological zone restrictions in force in the area of the "Wieliczka" Salt Mine Capital Group

- The maximum number of tourists in individual and organised groups is now limited from **30 to 20**.
- Tours are now to start **every 10 minutes, instead of every 4 minutes** (tours starting every 5 minutes are available for organised groups, which for example use one means of transport).
- The maximum number of people visiting the Graduation Tower is now limited from **150 to 50**. All persons visiting the area of the Graduation Tower are obliged to wear face masks. The Tower and the Viewing Terraces are available to visitors.
- The minimum distance between groups is now increased **from 20 to 30 metres**.
- The maximum number of people in lifts:
 - Daniłowicz Shaft: **5 people** per floor;
 - Regis Shaft: **limited from 9 to 6 people** (5 people + elevator staff).
- The number of checkout desks at retail outlets is increased – in line with the guidelines: **1 checkout for 5 visitors** (4 checkout desks in the Żupnik store and in the Regis top shaft building).

- All previously available excavations of the Tourist Route remain available to visitors.
- The free tourist movement zone in the area of the Wisła, Warszawa, Budryk, Staszic, Witos and Lill chambers starts with the Witos chamber. Tourists are asked to conform with social distancing measures.
- Catering activities work as always, observing a limit of 1 person per 4 m².
- Events, dance parties, weddings, occasional meetings, trade shows, congresses and other such activities remain suspended until further notice. Cultural events may be organised, while observing a participation limit of up to 25% of total available seats.
- The rules in force in the safe zone on the surface, including mandatory body temperature measurements remain unchanged.

Following the above-mentioned changes concerning the organisation of the tourist traffic we are also going to update the "Wieliczka" Salt Mine Capital Group sanitary safety policy during the COVID-19 epidemic and the tourist services price list, concerning the maximum group size.
