

Miners' Route

The journey that begins in the Regis Shaft – the oldest preserved shaft – is much more than just a sightseeing tour. It is an engaging adventure that activates all the senses and makes the blood run faster in the veins.

Just the first steps in the mine are already exciting! The route is narrow, leads through winding galleries, and the road must be illuminated by a miner's lamp. A few moments pass and the tourists climb up the ladder and experience complete darkness. Underground exploration allows them to learn about the harsh mine and feel like a miner working underground for a while.

On the way, every tourist becomes an apprentice of the mining trade, who learns the secrets of geology and mining techniques: checking the atmosphere, braiding ropes, crushing salt rocks and transporting the excavated material. An experienced foreman who leads the expedition gladly helps with a good word and gives advice on how to perform the tasks.

The sightseeing trail leads to a depth of 110 metres. By journeying deep under the surface of the earth, every tourist will experience the unique atmosphere of the salt underground.
