The mine has existed for more than 700 years and is a heritage site. In 1978, it was added to the UNESCO List of World Cultural Heritage.

What are the tasks of the mine?

The “Wieliczka” Salt Mine protects the historic underground workings and the surface of the town of Wieliczka, organises tourist traffic and conducts business.

Miners secure galleries and chambers.

They also take care of the safety of tourists and visitors.



Touring the Mine

Some of the galleries and chambers of the mine can be toured.



Visitors can experience the Tourist Route and the Miners' Route.



Various events take place underground, including concerts, balls and exhibitions.



People with respiratory diseases can take advantage of the underground Health Resort.



On the surface, near the buildings of the “Wieliczka” Salt Mine, there is the Graduation Tower.

It is a structure where you can breathe in salty air.
